
It was a fruitful discussion to help direct the Board and students mull over points for consideration to make the scoring and result of the class XII students comprehensive and impartial.

MCQs By GPSC In Association With Vidya Mandir Classes






Sister Shivani from Brahamakumaris initiated the convention spiritually with her talk on "Spiritual movement in India".


