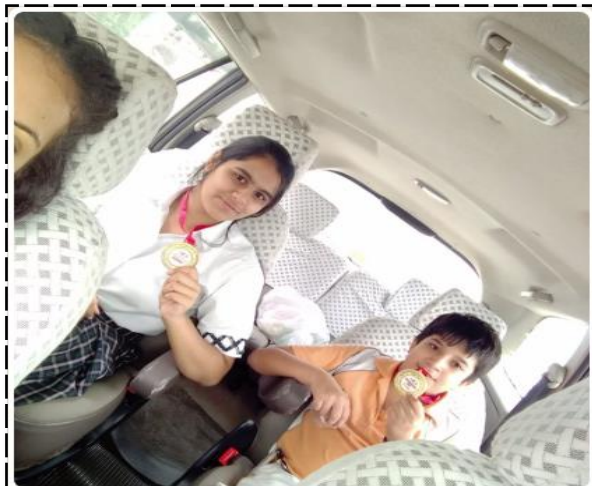

## SCIENCE AND VISUAL ARTS WEEK SESSION 2019 – 2020

*“Both science and art are human attempts to understand and describe the world around us.”*

Visual arts and Science have many things in common- the process of trial and error, innovating something new, experimenting and succeeding. In Suncity, we believe that by integration of subjects, learning becomes more stimulating. To make learning influential Suncity School celebrated Science and Visual Arts Week from 26-31 August 2019.

The activities planned during the week were aimed to explore different aspects of science and art and to motivate students to gain knowledge, to remember it longer to apply the skills they learn to personally relevant, real-world situations. The week was celebrated with great enthusiasm.

The inaugural PYP assembly on Monday 26th August, 2019 was on the topic "I was created to create" where the students spoke about scientists who are artists as well. They also presented a skit on the importance and functioning of the right and the left side of the human brain. The left side is more logical whereas the right side is more creative. Followed by a melodious song on the topic 'Science'.

MYP assembly was based on Amalgamation of oil and water – scientific and aesthetic aspect. The principal inaugurated the assembly by making a Lava lamp and cutting the ribbon of an art work made by students using water and oil medium. This was followed by a presentation by Aman Foundation (tree plantation drive), skit- Conserve what our children deserve, precious water- a presentation, a song 'keep it safe-It's our world' and demonstration cum presentation of a student model- Automated plant watering system.

On Tuesday and Thursday various activities combining science and art were conducted in classrooms and other venues.

Grade III presented zig-zag booklets prepared by them on the topic "My Herbarium". They also prepared 'Nature art' drawings based on nature using twigs, dried leaves and dried flowers.

Grade IV researched and created a collage on hybrid plants in groups. They presented their research as well. They also created 'Mosaic Art' by using small bits of paper from coloured paper, magazines or newspapers. Final race of India Innovate fly to the line glider race was conducted and winners declared.

Grade-V exhibited the working models prepared and assembled by them during "SPECTRA-The Science Fest". Students mesmerized the audience with scintillating presentations on various models. They also created paintings depicting optical illusions during this week.

Grade VI had a seed ball making workshop conducted by representatives from Aman foundation. They mixed mud with manure and water to make balls and then inserted seeds into them.

Grade VII and VIII witnessed the Final race of India Innovate Fly to wheels model rocket car race (in the basketball court). In class students worked in groups of 5 and make a collage on 'Art in Science'. (pictures of rainbow, constellations, aurora, waves etc)

Grade IX and X students converted a lesson/chapter from their science textbook into a poster (A 4 size) with a unique relevant heading.

In Wednesday MYP assembly an Inter House Science and Visual art Quiz was conducted. It consisted of five rounds

Round 1 – Name the Indian Scientist

Round 2 – Identify the Artist

Round 3- Mission Chandrayaan

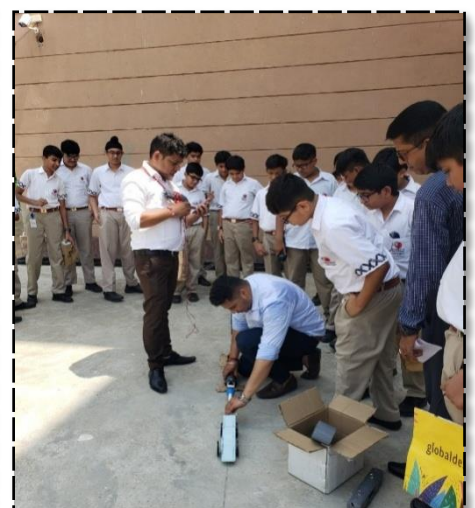
Round 4- Art Trivia

Indian house was declared the winner with a tie between pacific and atlantic house for second position.

The Friday MYP assembly was graced by a guest Ms Vandana Kothari professor Delhi college of planning and fine arts. The students presented “Sunshine on my shoulder”- A combination of song, dance and its pictorial depiction, “Lukmaan- ekkalakar” (short hindi play), presentation on artistic scientists (the scientific contribution by renowned artists) and a Dance- “Togetherness”. There was also a prize distribution for the winners of the India Innovate Fly to Wheels model rocket car race and glider race.

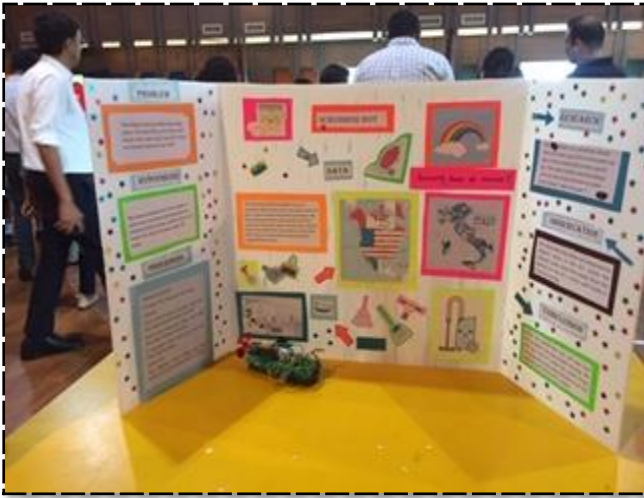
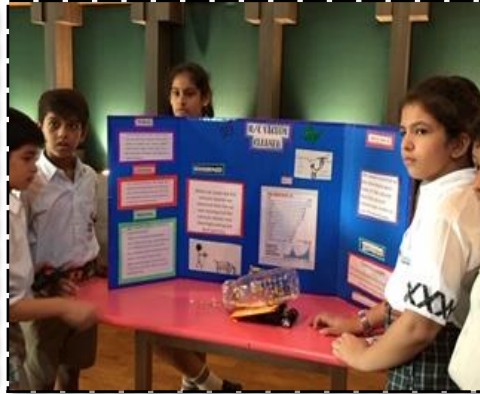
## BEHIND THE SCENES:

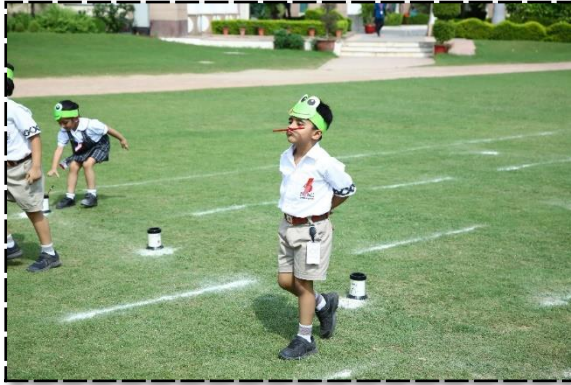

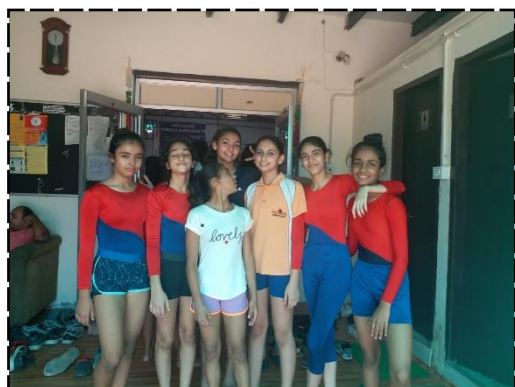

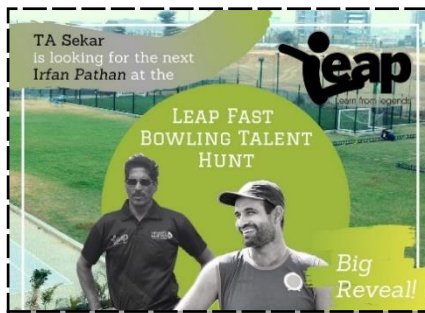
### **LEAP ACADEMY FAST BOWLING TALENT HUNT**
